



### MILDURA OPEN – CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The Committee of Management shall have the entire management of the Mildura open Tournament
2. Entries are restricted to amateurs who have a current Golf Australia Handicap and golf link number The Committee shall have the right to refuse entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
3. Competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the R&A and USGA, together with such local rules as are in force which are in place on the course which the competition takes place. If a dispute arises on any point the committee in charge shall decide it, whose decision shall be final.
4. Maximum Playing Handicap shall be **36 for Men** and **45 for Women**. Grades shall be determined by the number of entries received.
5. Leading players of each grade must be available for seeded groups on Sunday to be eligible to win major trophies
6. Any protest must be lodged with the Captain or Tournament Committee member, on which the disputed matter has arisen, prior to the presentation of trophies on the day.
7. Competitors shall be made Honorary members of the Mildura Golf resort for the duration of the Tournament.
8. Players must report to the pro shop 15 minutes before starting time. Any player not ready to commence play when called may be placed at the bottom of the field at the discretion of the Starter
9. A Player may win more than one Major trophy except for Veterans (Scratch Events take precedence over Handicap events)
10. The Tournament Committee may ballot out any player in the event should this be necessary.
11. DRESS: Neat and tidy attire at all times is required. Please **NO** track or leisure suits (Tops or Bottoms) Sleeveless or collarless shirts. **SOFT SPIKES ONLY**
12. Competition shall be played in accordance with the Mildura Golf Club Inc. Match Committee by Laws
13. In the event of a Tie for first place in **Scratch Event**, a result will be determined by play-off as determined by the Tournament Committee. **Handicap Event** shall be decided by count back as per Golf Australia
14. Women play on Sunday AM only, as the Women's Trophies shall be presented early afternoon at the conclusion of morning play.
